You guys should already have your grades figured out for graduating. There is a career option on the Bowling Green web site page called OCIS. If your still kind of iffy on what you want to

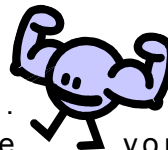
do then this program will help you figure out on what you are interested in. A n - other thing is taking advice from your elders. It gives you another perspective on what to do.
